1. Registration Fee: \$275 per Family. This fee is NON-REFUNDABLE. One yearbook for family is included in this fee. ** Due date is 02/01/2011 with registration paperwork.

2.Instructional Fees: Technology and General Fees

Technology Fee: \$100.00 per student. Covers computer programs, instructional materials and supplies. ** Due date in 04/01/2011. NON-REFUNDABLE after 6/30/2011

General Fee: \$350.00 per student. This fee covers a multitude of academic and student resources. Some of the items covered by the General Fee are as follows: Guidance Program fees, textbook rental, science lab materials, consumable workbooks, supplemental classroom novels, periodicals, testing materials, diocesan fees, school newspaper, sacramental expenses and library/ art supplies. ** Due date is 05/01/2011. NON-REFUNDABLE after 06/30/2011.

3.Dues

Home and School Dues: \$65.00 per family. ** Due date is 09/01/2011.

**In order to qualify for the 2% Tuition Discount, full payment must be in the school office by the end of the business day on August 1, 2011. Payment may be dropped off or mailed to the school office; postmark must be dated August 1 , 2011, or earlier.
